Job Title:	AmeriCorps Youth Counselor
Description:	This position is employed and funded by AmeriCorps but provides service at Briarpatch. This position provides counseling and case management to youth and their family members and provides support for volunteers in the Briarpatch Runaway & Homeless Youth Program (RHY). Duties are performed for outpatient clients and for youth residing in a temporary shelter facility.
Qualifications:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Experience working with at-risk youth. • Effective communication and organizational skills. • Spanish language skills a plus. • Valid driver's license required.
Duties & Responsibilities:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Provides intake counseling, case management, and referral services to youth and their families. • Establishes and maintains case files on assigned clients. Documents client contacts in case files, and completes case-related documentation in accordance with RHY Program and Agency standards. • Provides assistance, support, consultation, and training to RHY Program volunteers to assure that clients receive quality services in timely manner • Maintains a working knowledge of RHY Program and agency policies and procedures • Answers the RHY Program help-line as necessary. • Performs other reasonable and related duties as assigned.
Hours:	Flexible hours; some evenings required. Agency is open 9:00 AM to 8:00 PM Monday-Friday.
Transportation:	A valid driver's license and reliable transportation are required.
