Briarpatch provides a broad array of services to more than 3,000 runaway, homeless, at-risk, and court-involved youth annually.

Job Title:	Youth Counselor
Description:	This position provides Intensive Supervision Program (ISP) services to court-involved youth. This includes assisting clients in completing court ordered obligations and providing general counseling and case management services.
Qualifications:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Degree in human services or related field, or a minimum of 2 years paid employment working with youth ages 12-17. • Excellent written, verbal, and computer skills. • Demonstrated ability to work as a member of a team. • Preference will be given to those candidates who have experience working with youth of diverse, cultural backgrounds, knowledge of the Dane County youth justice system, and demonstrated ability to communicate and advocate for clients. • Ideal candidate will have group facilitation or teaching experience with youth ranging between 12-17 years old. • Ability to develop employment and/or community service opportunities would be considered a plus. • Knowledge of local community resources, services and provider networks also desirable.
Duties & Responsibilities:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Conduct client, family, and team meetings while providing individual and family support counseling, mentoring and tutoring services. • Promote youth accountability on behalf of the juvenile court, through monitoring services and case management. • Facilitate weekly competency development groups and connect clients with natural community supports. • Assist clients in completing court ordered restitution and community service obligations. • Consistently maintain client records on all assigned cases, and create and prepare monthly progress reports for the juvenile court. • Attend juvenile court hearings and school meetings.
Hours:	This is a 40 hour per week position, with flexible hours, based upon program and client needs. Evening and weekend hours are required.
Transportation:	A valid driver's license and reliable transportation are required.
Compensation Package:	Starting pay is \$17.10 per hour Benefits include: health, dental, life, & disability insurance; paid holidays; SEP/403B plan; flex spending account; mileage reimbursement; and generous paid time off.
